Fee:-

An application fee of Rs.500/- [plus bank charges as applicable] is to be paid using "State Bank Collect" which facilitates payment through Debit Card/Credit Card/Net Banking. Payment may also be made in cash at any State Bank of India after generating the Cash Deposit Form from "State Bank Collect" in final step of Online Application. Further instructions will be available during the online application process. **Candidates are required to carefully follow the steps while registering online.**

Please Note :-

1. Candidates will not be permitted to take admission **without Permanent Resident Certificate [PRC] after clearing Polytechnic Admission Test-2019. Therefore, the candidates are requested to keep the PRC ready well in advance for admission.**

Reservation: -Reservation of seats will be as per Govt. of Assam rules. For certain categories candidates will have to furnish certificates from the competent authorities as follows:-

1. **Freedom Fighter:-** For Grandson/Granddaughter of Freedom fighters [Both Paternal & Maternal]
 - A. Certificate from the Secretary to the Govt. of Assam, Home & Political Department.
 - B. A direct Relationship certificate of the candidate with the Freedom Fighter from the Deputy Commissioner or his authorized official of the district where the Freedom Fighter belongs.
2. **Retired Defense Personnel:-** (For son/daughter of Retired Defense Personnel):
 - A. Certificate from **the Director, Rajyik Sainik Board, Assam.**
3. **Central Govt. Employees:-** For son/daughter of Central Govt. and Central Govt. Public Sector Under taking serving in the State who are not Permanent Resident of Assam, but posted in Assam shall have to furnish following certificate from the head of the office where he is serving -
 - A. that his/her parents are not Permanent Resident of Assam, but from other State of India.
 - B. Date from which serving in Assam, of his /her parents in Assam as employee of Central Govt./ Undertakings.
 - C. Certificate from his /her school/college the candidate last attended

4. **OBC/ MOBC:- For students of Other Backward Classes/ More Other Backward Classes.**
- A. Certificate issued by the All Assam OBC/ MOBC Association countersigned by Deputy Commissioner / Sub Divisional Officer [Civil] of the concern District.
- B. Certificate issued by the Deputy Commissioner of the Concerned District for **students of Other Backward Classes/ More Other Backward Classes** as Non Creamy Layer is mandatory.
5. **Moran Community:- For students of Moran Community:**
- A. Certificate issued by the Assam Moran Sobha countersigned by Deputy Commissioner / Sub Divisional Officer [Civil] of the concern District.
- B. Certificate issued by the Deputy Commissioner of the Concerned District for Moran Community candidates as Non Creamy Layer under OBC/MOBC category is mandatory.
6. **TGLC/EX-TGLC:- For students of Tea Garden Labour Community/ Ex- Tea Garden Labour Community.**
- A. Certificate issued by the All Assam OBC/ MOBC Association countersigned by Deputy Commissioner / Sub Divisional Officer [Civil] of the concern District.
- B. Certificate issued by the Deputy Commissioner of the Concerned District for **Tea Garden Labour Community/ Ex- Tea Garden Labour Community** candidates as Non Creamy Layer under OBC/MOBC category is mandatory.
7. **Differently –Able For Differently Able Candidates:- Candidates:-**
- A. **For Identity Card as Differently-abled** issued by Social Welfare Department. Disability up to 40% and not exceeding 80% will be only eligible.
8. **Sports quota:- For Sports quota candidates :-**
- A. For admission against sports quota at State Polytechnics of Assam, the Candidates are to submit application after appearing in the admission test along with copies of marksheet of qualifying examination, PAT Admit Card and detailed particulars regarding their level of participations in the sport along with a copy of certificate from the Director of Sports, Assam .
9. **N.C.C. Category :- For N.C.C. quota Candidates:**
- For admission against NCC quota candidates are to submit application after appearing in the admission test along with copies of mark sheet of qualifying examination, PAT Admit Card and detail particulars along with the documents of Camp Attendance (if any) regarding their level of participations and a copy of certificate from the Director of NCC, Assam.

N.B.:- The application against Sports and NCC quota is to reach the office of the Director of Technical Education, Assam, Kahilipara, Guwahati-19 within 5 [five] days from the date of Examination of Admission Test -2019.

10. **Ministry of Human Resource Development [MHRD], Govt. of India Special scheme for Persons with Disabilities:-**

25 nos. of seats in different disciplines at **Assam Engineering Institute, Guwahati** are reserved exclusively under “ Person With Disabilities” [PWD] Scheme of **MHRD** in addition to normal reservation for differently- abled candidates, subject to approval of the Govt. of India and the following conditions:-

1. Candidates must qualify in Polytechnic Admission Test -2019.
2. Must be Permanent Resident of Assam and have appeared/ Passed HSLC or its equivalent examination in a single sitting with 35% marks in Mathematics and Science in aggregate.
3. The categories of PWDs to be considered for admission : visually Impaired [VI], Hearing Impaired [HI] and Orthopedically Handicapped [OH].
4. The minimum disability is 40% and not exceeding 80%.
5. The upper age limit is 21years as on 1st August-2019.

The Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India, will sponsor the such candidates with disability with Scholarships, Book grant, Educational Materials, Uniforms Free Boarding and lodging for Boarders and Travelling allowances for day scholars, Exemption from Payment of Admission Fee, Tuition Fee, excluding Examination fee etc.
